2012 APPLICATION Kneisel Hall Program for Maine Students

Session I

- Monday, June 18th, 9:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. recital.
- The program is open to string and piano students 9-12 years of age of advanced beginning to intermediate ability and reading skills.
- The day will include a morning rehearsal of intensive work on a selected piece, sight-reading in the afternoon and the final performance at 3:00 p.m.
- The application fee is \$25.00 and is due with the application.
- There is a program fee of \$50.00 for the Monday session
- Total money due Kneisel Hall - \$75.00 (application + program fees): **due June 1, 2012.**

Session II

- Tuesday, June 19th (9:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.) through Saturday June 23rd (10:00 a.m., ending with a 1:00 p.m. performance.)
- The program is open to string and piano students 12 to 18, of intermediate to advanced playing level and reading skills.
- The program includes intensive work on one chamber piece, master classes, piano 4-hands, mentor performances and sight singing, eurhythmics, or ear training.
- This is a DAY program; participants commute or arrange housing.
- The application fee is \$25.00 and is due with the application.
- There is a program fee - \$200 for the 4-day session
- Total money due Kneisel Hall - \$225, (application + program fees): **due June 1, 2012.**

To apply (both programs):

1. The application on the following page. It must be **postmarked March 12, 2012.**
2. \$25 application fee, made out to Kneisel Hall Program for Maine Students
3. A 3-5 minute tape or CD. Include: a lyrical passage and something of a quicker nature; accompaniment is optional. **LABEL** the tape with *your* name and the name of the *work*. Tapes & CD's will NOT be returned unless you include a stamped self-addressed envelope. There will be no live auditions.
